Do I need a referral?

Yes, this is required to claim a rebate from Medicare. GP referrals are valid for 12 months.

What do I need to bring?

- letter of referral
- Copies of relevant test results, if you have them
- X-rays or CDs (angiogram or CT angiogram)
- List of medications, names and doses
- Hospital discharge papers
- Medicare, pension or health care cards

How will I get there?

City bus routes 100, 222, 224 and 363 all enter the Rankin Park campus. Get off at the first stop after the Lookout Rd roundabout and walk to Croudace House (The Heights Medical Centre, about 5 min).

We are in Suite 7, Level 1, with a single flight of stairs. If you need to use the elevator, enter the smaller Newcastle Private Hospital building and follow the walkway from 1st floor.

If driving, parking is available in the Specialist Centre carpark (\$4/hour). Alternatively, park at the Knights stadium and use the shuttle bus.
